## Topic:

Our main topic this term is The Ancient Egyptians. We will be looking at where in the world Egypt is, what life was like for Ancient Egyptians and how they communicated.

There will be opportunities for children to look at and handle artefacts linked to this period of history and use their investigative

## Maths:

We will be focusing on place value of number. This will include reading and writing numbers as digits and in words up to 1000. We will be partitioning 3-digit numbers in hundreds, tens and thousands and ordering numbers. We will also use the vocabulary of multiples linked to tens and hundreds. E.g. 300 is a multiple of 100, 560 is a multiple of 10.

## Spellings:

We will be assessing the children's knowledge of the statutory words from Year 2 and starting to practice and use words from the Year 3 list. We will continue to use phonic knowledge to support spelling and reading of words. We will also look at different spelling patterns.

## English:

We will start the year with a focus on handwriting and presentation, making sure that we start as we mean to go on. A focus on verbs, adjectives and nouns will help us with character and setting descriptions and our main text will be heavily linked to The Ancient Egyptians.

## P.E:

Outdoors, we will be playing invasion games, using the skills such as dribbling, passing and defending. Indoors, we will be developing our flexibility, strength, technique and control when running, throwing and jumping.

## Art:

Our main focus will be investigating and creating 3-D form, using the work of Artist Ashraf Hanna as inspiration.
