Maths:

When the children first return to school, we will be starting with a unit on Time. We will be learning how to tell the time on both analogue and digital clocks. Then we will move on to a unit on Shape and ending with a unit on Statistics

Spellings:

We will continue to set spellings each week on ED Shed as homework to recap previous learning and support improving common misconceptions. The children will also be focusing on learning the Year 3&4 Common Exception Words.

English:

In English this half term, the children will be writing a retell on a book linked to conservation, a diary entry from a main character in another book as well as a biography linked to one of our Little People Big Dreams figures. Skills include, complex sentences with subordinating conjunctions and fronted adverbials for frequency and degree.

Design and Technology

This half term, our huge focus is preparing for our Trashionshow. The children spent most of Summer 1 learning how to draw different items of clothing and sketching different ideas. They were then put into groups, to merge ideas and create their final piece. The children now need to work together as a team to make their outfit ready for our show! Similarly, as part of our life skills and DT curriculum, the children will be making Vanilla Cheesecakes with a fruit topping.

Science

In Science this half term, we will focus on learning about the Human Body. We will be learning about the different organs and the digestive system. We will also be looking at the affect different liquids have on teeth and learning how to draw food chains.

Music:
