



INTENT

- *For children to enjoy and have a love for art and the opportunity to be creative in their own way.*
- *To encourage children to be creative and take ownership of their work.*
- *To promote an inclusive art curriculum where all children feel they can work freely without restraints and a fixed mind set around their artistic ability, allowing them to become more confidence.*
- *To teach the key skills, vocabulary and techniques outlined in our curriculum. Revisit, develop and finally master these skills and children's understanding year on year through to year 6.*
- *To teach the whole art process including artist study, experimenting with different tools and mediums and using artist's work to inspire their own creation.*
- *To use a range of mediums and tools and be taught how to use them accordingly, using more as they progress through the school.*
- *To link art to the real world, teaching them about old and current artists and the process of the artist's work, not only the finished piece.*

IMPLEMENTATION

- *Provide an enjoyable, inclusive and engaging art curriculum.*
- *To promote a positive and open attitude when teaching art allowing children to feel 'safe' to express themselves and experiment with new techniques.*
- *To teach sketching, painting and colour and 3D art explicitly, allowing children to understand and master the skills throughout the school.*
- *Children to be exposed and taught different mediums and tools and be explicitly taught their names and use.*
- *Expose and discuss key artists as well as studying a focus artist in detail.*

IMPACT

- *Children leave year 6 with the mind-set that anyone can be an 'artist' in their own way.*
- *Children to be able to understand the process of creating a 'finished' piece of artwork.*
- *Children to be able to share and discuss different forms of art.*
- *Children will be confident in their ability to use a range of mediums and tools to create any artwork.*
- *Children to know of and share different artists and the main medium they use.*
