INTENT

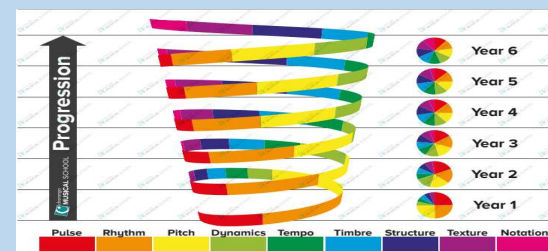
- ❖ For children to communicate thoughts, feelings and ideas through the medium of music.

- ❖ To develop improvisation and composition skills half termly using the Charanga scheme, building upon previously learnt knowledge (cross-curricular links with English and Topic lessons).
- ❖ To provide children with the opportunities to engage with peripatetic music teachers and to deepen their musical creativity with a variety of instruments.
