Intent

- To provide and expose children to a variety of good quality books.

Implementation

- Each class visits the library weekly.
- All children and staff have their own barcodes to borrow books.
- Library monitors keep the library tidy and organised, and report any issues/problems to Library Co-Ordinator.
- Library Co-Ordinator ensures all staff are confident with the Libresoft Librarian software.
- Books regularly checked and repaired/ removed if necessary.
- New books regularly purchased.
- Library Co-Ordinator discusses future book purchases with subjects.
- Regular pupil voice surveys with children.
- Questionnaires emailed to teachers.

- Children will be able to read a variety of good texts to choose from.
- Children will have access to an organised and tidy library.
- Children improve and develop their reading skills.
- children enjoy visiting the library.
- Children respect and value books.
- children are encouraged to visit their local/ other libraries.
